Fig. 1 Maps showing atmospheric and ocean circulation in the Pacific during a normal year and an El Niño year.

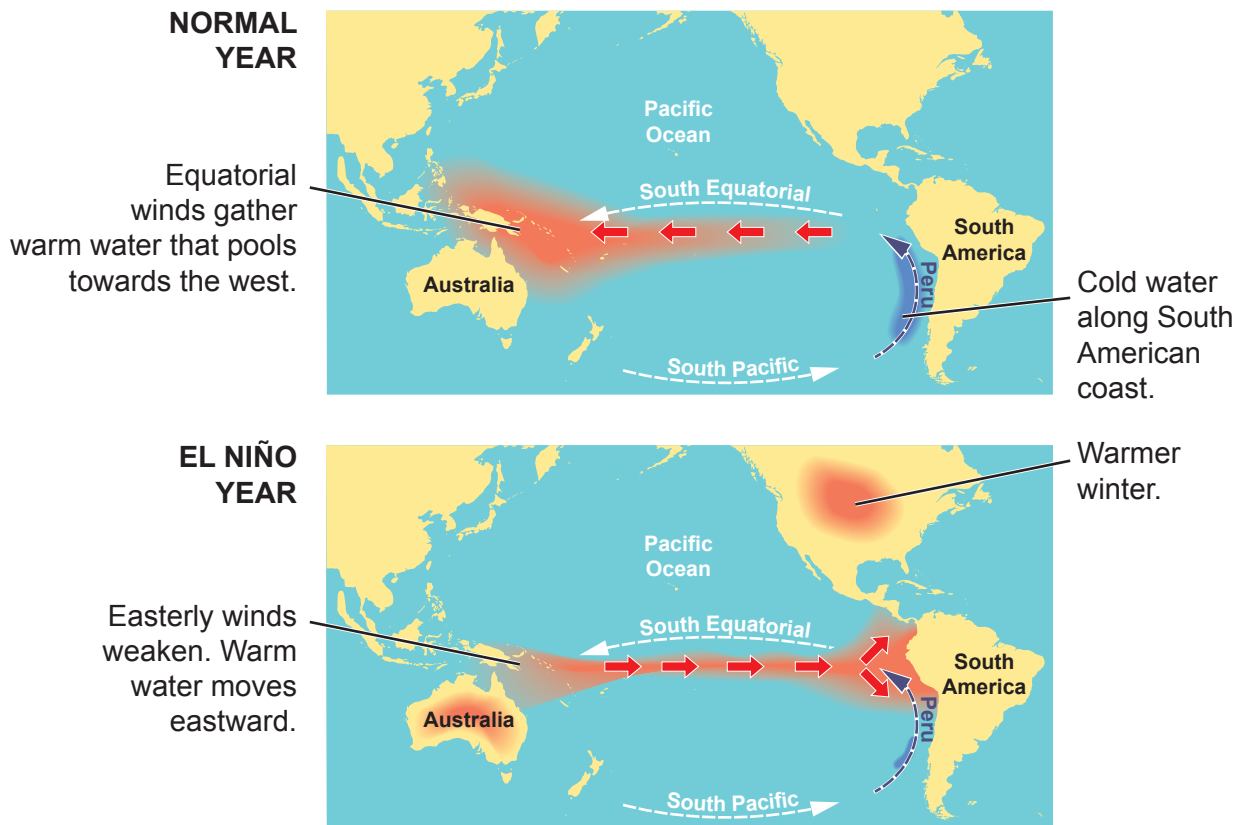
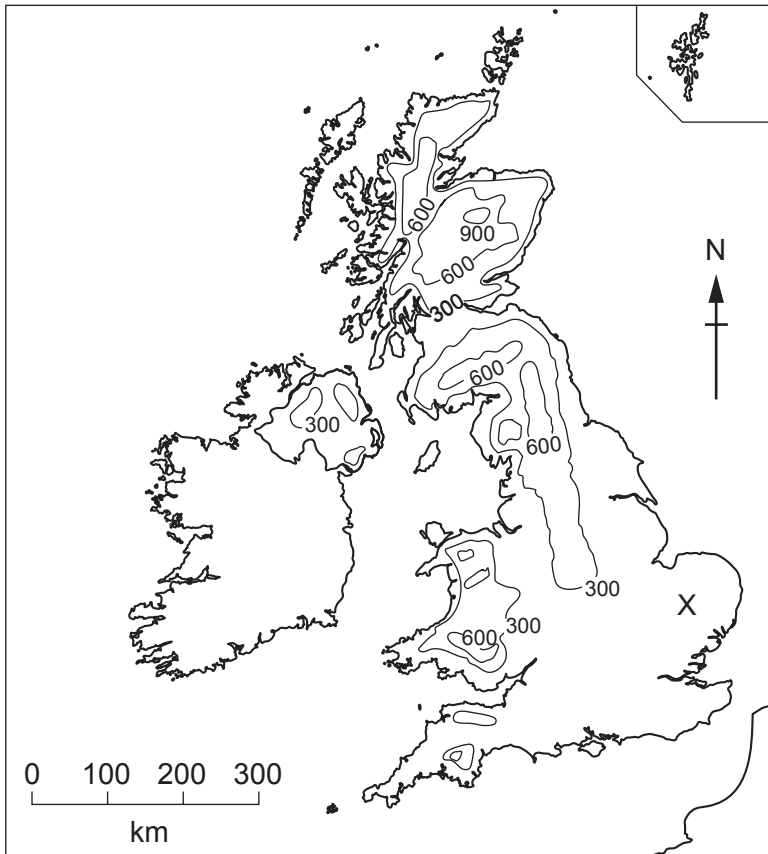


Fig. 2 A painting from 1677 of the frozen River Thames



Fig. 3 A relief map of the UK



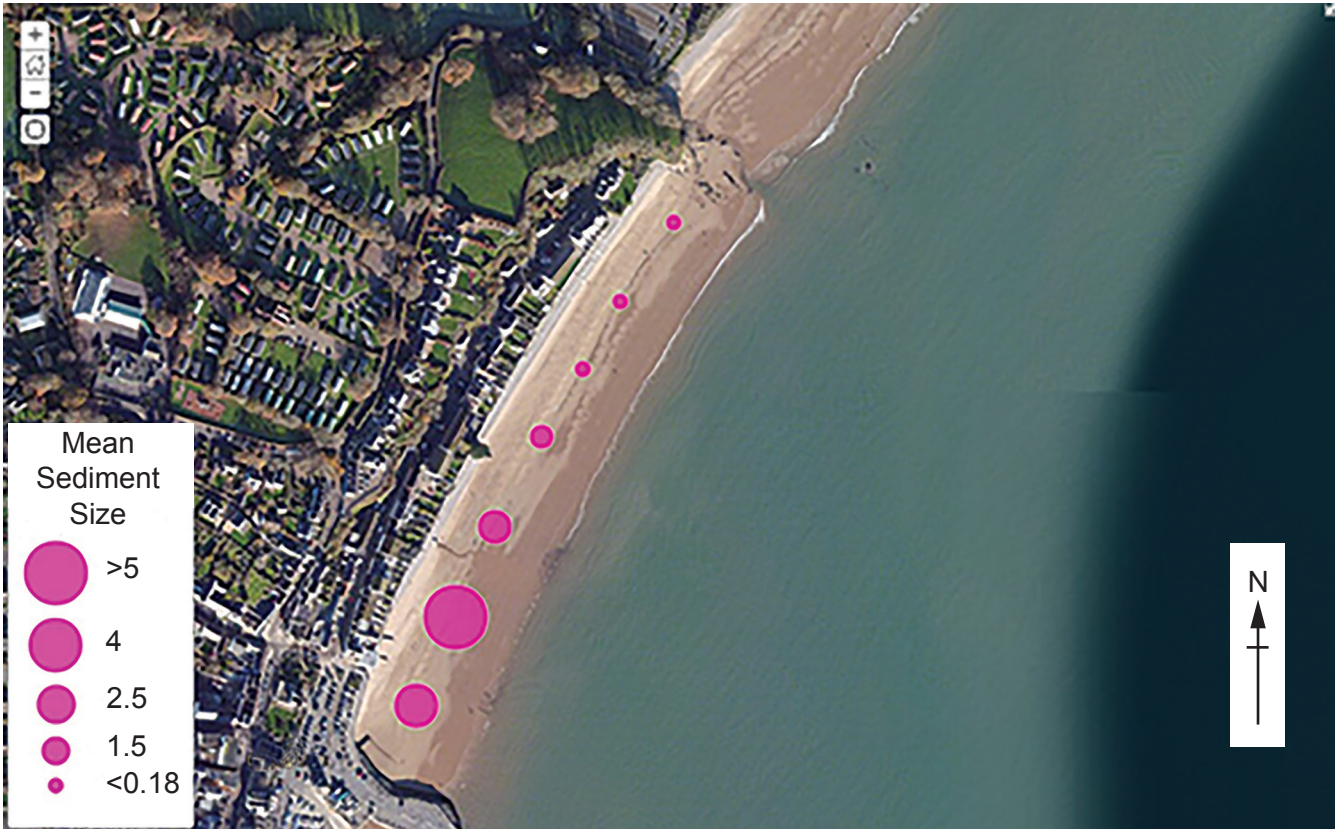
